

Life Paths Promising Advocate Award

We are offering four scholarships for participants who focus on advocacy for under-served or marginalized communities. Scholarships include conference registration and 2 nights' lodging at the Scarritt-Bennett center (if we are able to host the conference in person).

Applicants must meet both of the following eligibility criteria: 1) Currently working at a non-profit organization serving people or communities who are historically underserved or have experienced violence, marginalization, or distress, and 2) Less than 7 years' professional experience in the field.

Scholarship winners are expected to attend the entire conference. The deadline to apply is November 9, 2020, 11:59 PM CST.
